5. What underlying purpose has God accomplished thru the stumbling of Israel? (11)
6. What question does Paul propose concerning Israel’s fall? (12)
7. How does Paul answer vs 12? (13-15)
8. Explain what is meant by branches, broken off, engrafted, wild... (16-18)
9. What warning does is given to the engrafted branches? (19-21)
10. What can God do to the original branches that were taken away? (22-24)
11. What “mystery” is revealed in vs 25? Explain to the best of your knowledge. (25)
12. How will God fulfill His covenant with Israel? (26-27)
13. Explain the relationship to election for Israel and the gospel for non Israel. (28-29)
14. Explain how God’s mercy is to both Jew & Gentile? (30-33)
15. Explain why Paul asks these three questions... what is he teaching us? (34-35)
16. Explain the words “of him” “through Him” and “to Him.” (36)
