- I. What is God's goal for my life? Romans 8:28-30
 - A. God works things in our lives for good.
 - 1. God is at work in your life.
 - 2. This is good news!
 - 3. God is at work for your good!
 - 4. What is the good God is after?
 - B. God is working to conform us into the image of His Son.
 - 1. God is transformation us to be like Jesus.
 - 2. This is God's plan for our lives—to make us holy.
- II. What is Satan's goal for my life? Genesis 3:1-7
 - A. Satan's goal for your life is to destroy you. 1 Peter 5:8
 - B. Satan's goal is to deceive you. John 8:44
- III. Where does Biblical change begin?
 - A. Biblical change begins with God's Word taking root in your heart/mind.
 - 1. Psalm 1
 - 2. Psalm 19:7-11
 - 3. Romans 12:1-2
 - 4. Ephesians 4:17-24
 - 5. Philippians 2:5
 - B. You cannot change your life without first changing your mind.
 - 1. Thinking impacts feelings
 - 2. Feelings impact actions.
 - 3. Actions impact results.
 - 4. Results impact thinking/feelings.
 - 5. Mood follows actions.
 - C. How is our mind renewed (transformed)?
 - 1. Our minds need renewed—that is, our minds are naturally opposed to God and His ways. Ephesians 4:17-18
 - 2. Not merely behavioral change although that is included.
 - 3. The Holy Spirit renews our minds. Titus 3:5
 - 4. The Holy Spirit uses the Word of God in which we see the glory of God to transform us. 2 Corinthians 3:18
