 - 2. We are dead to sin. (2)
 - 3. We are baptized into Christ' death. (3)
 - 4. God intends for us to share also in Christ's resurrection. (4-5)
 - 5. We know that our old self was crucified with Christ. (6-7)
 - 6. We live with Christ. (8-10)
 - 7. We must reckon ourselves dead to sin but alive to God. (11)
 - 8. We must therefore offer ourselves to God. (12-13)
 - 9. Sin shall not have dominion over you. (14)
 - B. Believers should live free from sin's control, embracing their new identity in Christ, and walk in holiness, empowered by His grace and resurrection life.
