- V. A closer look at Romans 6:1-14.
  - A. How should believers live in light of their union with Christ according to Romans 6:1-14?
    1. We are united to Christ. (6:1-14)
    2. We are dead to sin. (2)
    3. We are baptized into Christ' death. (3)
    4. God intends for us to share also in Christ's resurrection. (4-5)
    5. We know that our old self was crucified with Christ. (6-7)
    6. We live with Christ. (8-10)
    7. We must reckon ourselves dead to sin but alive to God. (11)
    8. We must therefore offer ourselves to God. (12-13)
    9. Sin shall not have dominion over you. (14)
  - B. Believers should live free from sin's control, embracing their new identity in Christ, and walk in holiness, empowered by His grace and resurrection life.
